WHAT ARE YOUR HEART'S DESIRES? If you delight yourself in God and His service, He's promised to give you the desires of your heart (Psalm 37:4).

God apparently feels that nothing is too good for His obedient children. If we please Him, we not only get what we need, but usually even what we *want*, above our needs, “exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think” (Ephesians 3:20).

He's willing to give us anything that's good for us, but He doesn't always let us have those things that He knows *aren't* good for us. He tried that on the children of Israel. He let them have the desires of their hearts a few times when it wasn't good for them, but then He had to send leanness to their souls to try to teach them a lesson (Psalm 106:15).

(Prayer:) Lord, help us to put You first, to delight ourselves in You and Yours most of all so You can trust us with other things—everything we need and even things we want—because they will not come between You and us. If it's good for us, let us have it, but if it's *not* good for us, please keep it from us. Amen.
