

Eternal salvation by grace means once saved always saved.



“HE WHO BELIEVES IN THE SON HAS EVERLASTING LIFE” (John 3:36). Right now! No ifs, ands, or buts about it! If you’ve received Jesus, you already have it. You don’t have to worry if you are going to have it, if you are going to fall from grace, if you are going to manage to stay saved, or if you are going to manage to keep true and then finally be given the reward of salvation for your faithfulness. Salvation is *not* a reward. It’s not pay; it’s not wages. It is a *gift* that you don’t earn by faithfulness or by any righteousness or works of your own (Titus 3:5). None of these can keep you saved any more than they can save you in the first place. Only *Jesus* can do it. “The gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord” (Romans 6:23).

A works salvation is no salvation at all. You cannot be good enough. No matter how many good deeds you do, they won’t save you. “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God” (Ephesians 2:8). It’s impossible to save yourself. You have eternal life, which is the gift of God, and you cannot lose it, for He will keep you. You’re the Lord’s forever!
