

## Do all you do to the glory of love.



**W**HATEVER WE DO IN WORD OR IN DEED, we're to do all to the glory of God (1 Corinthians 10:31). God is love (1 John 4:8), so we're to do it all to the glory of *love*. There is no law but love in God's kingdom of love (Galatians 5:14). Love is what counts. God is love, His law is love, and our faith and practice are love. Isn't that a wonderful religion?
