GOD SAID THROUGH MOSES THAT WITHOUT THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD THERE IS NO REMISSION OF SIN (Leviticus 17:11). That was the Law, and that is why Jesus died for us.

Jesus died on God’s altar, the cross, believed upon by every Christian, trusted by every son and daughter of God who believes in Jesus Christ for their salvation.
