

## Jesus is the Word of God.



**T**HE GOSPEL OF JOHN begins with one of the most profound statements in the entire Bible: “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made” (John 1:1–3 KJV). That’s one of the deepest truths in the Bible—that Jesus is the Word of God, the *expression* of God, as well as the *Son* of God.

What is a word? It’s a means of communication. When God wanted to communicate His love to the world, what did He do? You can’t see love and you can’t see God, so He sent His Word. He said it in Jesus. He showed it in Jesus. He expressed it in Jesus. He communicated it in Jesus. Jesus was all of that. He was the expression of God’s love. He was the meaning of God’s love. He was the communication of God’s love. He said God’s love. He showed God’s love. He symbolized God’s love. He manifested God’s love. He was and *is* God’s own message of love to us!
