ONE OF JESUS' LAST MESSAGES TO HIS DISCIPLES WAS "FEED MY SHEEP" (John 21:16 KJV). What He meant by that, of course, is that He wants us to have real love for the lost, to tell others about His love, and to feed them spiritually with His Word.
