

“God is a Spirit” (John 4:24 KJV).



GOD IS THE SPIRIT OF LOVE. He’s the Great Spirit, the Creator. He’s not some old bearded gentleman way off somewhere, or some kind of ferocious monster that you can’t understand, but He is the guiding light of the universe, the all-powerful, omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent spirit that pervades all things. He is in everything, and everything is part of God, in a sense (Acts 17:28; Colossians 1:16–17).

God dwells in life.
